

5th FIAP CLUBS' WORLD CUP

**Introduction by Jacky Martin
Director of FIAP Biennial Service**

In 2009, 104 clubs from 33 countries entered a total of over 2000 photos for the 4th FIAP World Cup for Clubs.

These figures affirmed the value of such a competition. However, once again there was a slight decline in participation rate. This has led us to propose an amendment to the regulations, providing the option for each author to participate with 4 photos instead of the current two. This major change will allow clubs to compete with only five authors. Thus, smaller clubs can face other clubs within the big family of FIAP without any disadvantage.

I remember that all ILFIAP clubs can enter the World Cup free of fee. Also, each of their participation will be given 5 basic points of acceptance, which can be accumulated for the newly created CAFIAP or CEFIAP distinctions. I am happy to note that a number of ILFIAP clubs have already accumulated enough acceptance points to qualify for the CAFIAP distinction. Information on ILFIAP membership and clubs' distinctions can be obtained from the FIAP secretary fiap@fiap.net or on the website www.fiap.net.

The English club *Wigan 10 Foto Club* won the FIAP World Cup in 2006, followed by the Italian club *Cupolone G.F. II*, in 2007, the Argentinean *Foto Club Quilmes* in 2008, and the Belgian club *Iris Lede* in 2009. I invite your club to participate in the fifth edition of the World Cup in 2010 and, perhaps, have your club's name recorded after these four prestigious international clubs.

INVITATION

The International Federation of Photographic Art, invites you to take part in the *5th FIAP Clubs' World Cup* to be held in **PARIS** from 03/10/10 to 28/02/11.

CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

Each club, member of FIAP or not may enter a CD-Rom containing 20 colour and/or black and white digital works. **At most four works per author.**

There is no coherence required between works.

Operational Members cannot participate.

Please note the new rules : 20 works mandatory, 4 photos maximum per authors.

WORKS SIZE

Files will be RGB mode, JPG 10 compressed, 300dpi, 2400 pixels minimum for the larger side in order to be printed for the exhibition.

Files will be named with the club name followed by a number from 01 to 20.

An entry-form, Excel, Word or text format must be on the CD with the works.

ENTRY FEE

There is no fee for ILFIAP Clubs, which already pay a member fee to FIAP.

The entry fee is **50€** (no \$) per club no FIAP member, to be paid :

PRIZES

The FIAP Clubs' World Cup is awarded as follows :

Clubs' World Cup for the best club.

FIAP Gold medal for the club which comes second.

FIAP Silver medal for the club which comes third.

FIAP Bronze medal for the club which comes fourth.

Six honourable mentions for the clubs which come 5th to 10th.

The authors of the club coming first receive an honourable mention.

One FIAP gold medal, two FIAP silver medals and three FIAP bronze medals will award works of exceptional quality, independently of the clubs' classification.

Each judge will choose his special favourite.

Each author can only receive one prize.

CATALOGUE – EXHIBITION

Each participating club will receive a catalogue on CD-Rom.

All accepted works will be reproduced in the catalogue.

Prize-winning works as well as one work per author from the Club winner of the World Cup will be shown at the FIAP headquarters gallery.
